We are pleased to announce a survey exhibition of work by Kim Adams. For this exhibition we survey Adams plans, drawings and models, his activity and many projects, both national and international, selected from the years 1979 to the present.

The majority of the exhibition is comprised of two-dimensional work, from small sketches on napkins through larger working drawings and plans made available for the first time. It provides a rare opportunity to glimpse how Adams develops his work.

The viewer will see the working process for completed major projects such as *Auto Office Haus*, from *Skuptur Projekte Munster*, Germany, 1997 and 2007; the Vancouver Art Gallery permanent installation of *Squid Head*; and *Fish House*, from *Ice Follies*, North Bay Art Gallery, Ontario, now in the collection of The National Gallery of Canada.

Among the works included is the initial drawing, sketched on an envelope, for *Toaster Work Wagon*, the ongoing project first exhibited in the international exhibition *In Site 1997*, San Diego, California and Tijuana, Mexico, and subsequently shown at (among others) Art Chicago 1998 – Rhona Hoffman Gallery and Wynick/Tuck Gallery, The MacLaren Centre, Barrie, On., 2007 and with *Cracker Box* in his major survey exhibition at the Power Plant, Toronto, 2001 and in Art Grandeur Nature (2000 Biennial) Paris, France.

*Pipe-dream* is the name of a new model that Adams has made for the Gallery to be featured in our booth at TIAF, opening next Thursday, October 25. We will also have one of Adams double-headed bikes mounted on the booth. Adams will be present at the opening.

And on the evening of Friday October 26, the goodwater gallery, Toronto , opens a wall drawing by Adams called *Don't Look Back*. The opening starts at 8:00pm with Adams present. [www.goodwatergallery.com](http://www.goodwatergallery.com)
